

- 1. Numbers must be on the side of the box from the direction the route carrier enters the area.
- 2. All snow must be removed on the approach and depart If the plow hits the box or pole, the Village will replace it; however, they will not install it. If snow hits it, it is the home/business owner's responsibility.

You can take it to the transfer station on Saturday from 9:30—3:30 and the attendant can show you the proper disposal location.

Zoning Ordinance— The Village of Kaleva now has a zoning ordinance which came into effect July 4, 2013.

Copies of the new ordinance are available in the village office for a fee of \$10, or you can request an electronic copy free of charge. There is also a reading copy at the Kaleva Library.

ORV Ordinance— ORVs are allowed on village streets with some rules and regulations. You must have an operator's or chauffeur's license or permit issued by the Secretary of State. ORV includes, but not limited to: multi-track or multi-wheel drive vehicle, motorcycle or related, 2 wheel, 3 wheel, or 4 wheel vehicle, amphibious machine, air cushion vehicle. Please see Ordinance No. 34 if you have questions.

Snow Removal Ordinance (Ord #35)— Removal required by all owners or occupants of any parcel within the Business district of the Village within 24 hours after any snow or ice storm shall cease if the ice or snow results in between 1 and 4 inches.

Within 48 hours after any snow or ice storm shall cease if the result is 4 or more inches. Penalties include: cost of village removing the snow, a civil infraction subject to fines up to \$500, and/or a lawsuit to collect expenses for removal.
